Counseling and educational programs prepare our residents to make loving and informed decisions for themselves and their babies.

Our overall program includes three primary programs which comprise the following: The Parenting Program, Transition Program (Phase I and Phase II) and our Adoption Program. Each one is unique instilling values and dignity while fostering skills for independent living. Residents receive ongoing assistance with job training, education and career opportunities as well as financial and spiritual guidance. We also offer classes in nutrition, prenatal health, childbirth and parenting.

Over 2000 mothers and babies have passed safely through the doors of Casa Teresa and Hannah's House and on to a better life. The love and dedication of the volunteers have made a difference in their lives.
